MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VENTURA COUNTY LAW LIBRARY HELD April 14, 2021.

A telephonic meeting was held on Wednesday, April 14, 2021 at 12:15 p.m. Present were board members Ms. Rodriguez, Judge Wright, Ms. Bautista, and Mr. Campbell, as well as Secretary Katie Drow. Mr. Woodward was not present. The meeting was called to order at 12:16 p.m.

Item 1, a public comment from Legal Aid was read aloud.

Item 2, the Law Library's response to the pandemic and reopening procedures, was discussed.
